

Catering – there is catering in the show hall from 8.00 am

Clerking/assistance – if you are able to clerk or help in any way please complete the section on the entry form or e-mail the show manager. Clerks will be paid - £25 per day for licenced clerks, £20 per day for un-licenced clerks. All clerks will receive lunch. Stewards will be paid £10 per day.

Kittens – Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 calendar months on the date of show. Neutered kittens may be entered.

Household pets – HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

EW Regional Fund – a donation per cat will be made to the Western Europe Regional Fund. Additional funds are gratefully accepted

Registration – with the exception of New Breeds & New Traits, registration with TICA is not required to compete in a cat's first show. However, registration is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional & International awards.

Show rules – TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. The official show rules may be obtained from \$7.00 from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or www.tica.org

Vetting in – Sat 7.30 – 8.45 Sun 8 – 8.45

Health requirements – this is a **vetted** show. Up to date vaccination cards must be produced at check in. The show manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections etc. in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from household where there has been an infectious disease/fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat obviously pregnant or lactating

will be disqualified. All claws, front & back, must be clipped prior to judging.

Exhibitors should check in both days in order for absentee lists to be compiled for the judges

Judging is from 9am to 4.30pm both days. Cats may not leave the show hall prior to the advertised hours without the show manager's consent.

Benching – Double SPACES (4ft x 2ft x 2ft) will be supplied by the club. Owners may supply their own pens at no extra cost. Metal pens may be hired at £5 per day. Benching requests should be made with the entry, however no guarantee is made. Litter bins will be provided but **exhibitors are requested to bag their rubbish before placing in the bins.** Exhibitors should supply their own litter trays, litter, cat food & water.

Airports – Manchester/Doncaster//East Midlands & Leeds. The nearest airport operating the PETS system is Manchester. The club is unable to offer transport.

Confirmations – Please enclose an SAE if an e-mail address has not been supplied. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued – please check them carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail before the closing date for entries, please contact the entry clerk.

Friendly reminder – Please leave the hotel room in the condition you find it & remove all cat litter. The condition of the rooms after departure reflects on the entire cat fancy. Please ensure that the hotel allows us to use it again. You will be liable for any cleaning costs deemed necessary by the hotel.
